We believe that cultivating a Chesed mindset is essential to Avodat Hashem. To support this, we partner with a variety of organizations in Yerushalayim, who welcome our students as volunteers for a few hours each week. In the past, students have served as "Big Sisters" for One Family Fund, an organization dedicated to assisting victims of terror and their families, helped at the local chapter of Friendship Circle, volunteered at Shalva—the Israel Association for the Care and Inclusion of Persons with Disabilities—and made regular visits to Beit Sababa, a local nursing home.

In recent years, our efforts have extended to the Arnona/Armon Hanatziv community, assisting families with special needs children, homebound senior citizens, and recently we have provided significant support to families of IDF soldiers on extended reserve

duty. We also provide regular group volunteering opportunities, featuring both pre-planned events and spontaneous initiatives that respond to emerging needs in the community and all over Israel.
